We hope that you have a blessed Christmas. Thank God for his gift to us of his son, Jesus. He is so good to us.

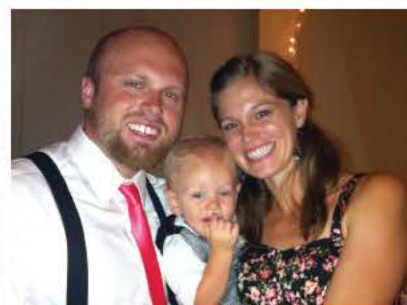
